Copenhagen Airport

Copenhagen Airport (Kastrup) is situated southeast of Copenhagen, 13 kilometres from Statistics Denmark and 8-10 kilometres from the city centre.

The **metro** from Copenhagen Airport to Christianshavn, Kongens Nytorv and Nørreport runs approx. every 5 minutes and is the fastest and most economical way to get into the city.

A **regional train** from Copenhagen Airport to the Central Station (Hovedbanegården), Nørreport or Østerport Station runs every 10 minutes.

A **taxi** from Copenhagen Airport to the city centre is around 250 DKK; and from the airport to Statistics Denmark around 300 DKK.

Public transport

Tickets can be bought in the busses or at the train and metro stations. A single ticket for 2 zones is valid for 1 hour and costs 24 DKK.

From the **airport** to the city centre you need a 3 zones ticket; it costs 36 DKK for one journey.

Statistics Denmark

Statistics Denmark (Danmarks Statistik) is situated in the neighbourhood called Østerbro. The distance to the city centre is 4 kilometres.

On the first day of the meeting, **visitors** report at the reception unless other agreements have been made.

There is a canteen at Statistics Denmark where you can choose from a buffet with hot meals, salads, soups, cold cuts and bread. The buffet most often serves both vegetarian, fish and different kinds of meat.

Regarding the dress code, Statistics Denmark is a relatively informal organization.

Transport to Statistics Denmark

The following **public busses** stop close to Statistics Denmark at the corner of Lyngbyvej/Haraldsgade and Sejrogade (red line on the map) (www.moviatrafik.dk):



- Bus **no 14** runs from the Central Station (Hovedbanegården) via Nørreport station towards Østerbro, Ryparken
- Buses **no 150S** and **184/185** run from Nørreport Station.

The nearest **S-train** station is **Ryparken Station**, about 750 metres from Statistics Denmark (10 minutes' walk – blue line on the map). S-trains from both Central Station and Nørreport stop there regularly.
